2 How to participate

In order to enter this competition you must design a clothes patch which people can sew/iron onto clothing, which celebrates NATS in the Skies above Britain TV series.

Please design your patch on a piece of paper no bigger than an A4 piece of paper. The actual patch may be any shape you like (circular, square even a triangle). Designs can be made in pencil or coloured in. It is not necessary to provide the actual material patch, as one of the winning entries will be made into an actual patch based on the drawing.

If you wish to remain anonymous then please do not enter your details, however for administrative reasons we will need your details to contact you if you win and to publish your names as winners.

Entries where the details provided which are incomplete, misspelt, inaudible, or incomprehensible are void and will not be entered into this prize draw.

This prize draw is open to all UK residents including employees and directors of NATS and their immediate families. Any participant under the age of 13 is not eligible for the tour of the simulator at Heathrow but can still win and get their patch made up. Anyone under 18 years of age who is selected as a winner and given a tour of the simulator at Heathrow House, must be accompanied on the simulator tour by a parent or guardian.

Each person may only submit one entry to this competition .

3 Start Date

This prize draw will start from 24th August 2016.

4 Closing Date and Time

The closing date and time for this prize draw will be 17.00 BST on 30th September 2016.

5 Selection of the Winners

Four winners of the prize will be selected by the judges by 10.00 a.m. 15th October 2016

There will be no categories in accordance with age, all entries will be judged against each other and the four winners will be selected from all of the entries.

Judges decision will be final and the selection will be made upon their artistic discretion no correspondence, entries not returned, no replacement/cash alternative.

You acknowledge that you and your patch may be required to be used in publicity if you are selected as a winner.

6 Prizes

The Prizes are as follows:

The 4 prize draw winners will each receive a tour of the simulator

The overall winner will have their patch design made into an actual patch and will receive one patch.

No cash alternative will be offered.

NATS reserves the right to substitute any of the prizes with one of an equivalent or greater value.

The Prizes are non-transferable and exclude any additional costs and expenses.

7 Restrictions and requirements

Please note the following restrictions and requirements apply to the prize draw:

Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain parental consent before entering and as stated above where they are between the ages of 13 and 18 will need to have a parent/guardian present when visiting the Simulator if they are chosen as a winner.

Entry into this prize draw is taken as acceptance of these terms and conditions.

All travel arrangements and expenses to Heathrow House for the winning participants shall be the responsibility of the respective winning participants.
